Comments / Recommendations:

(notes taken directly from Data Collection Sheets)

Man took 4 bags of rocks and shells license plate # 4GDV279, excessive styrofoam and cigarette butts in the scattered piles of kelp (in the high tide line), we were joined by 3 young people from the firm that is working with the City of SC to redevelop North Beach, the area seemed a lot cleaner than usual, Maybe another team just cleaned?, NO TAR this time!, many small pieces of styrofoam, 75-100 pieces of styrofoam, **place trash cans at all fire pits (recommendation)**, many pieces of small styrofoam, lots of foil and plastic food wrappers (and pieces of wrappers), lots of little styrofoam pieces – but less than last time, small pieces of styrofoam & plastic too numerous to count, included larger plastic items such as bottles or lids in count above, overwhelming number of cig butts by the bathroom, styrofoam pieces too numerous to count, lots of little candy wrappers, fire pit areas are really trashy, this was a combined event with SC Green and SC Historical Society – those 2 groups have separate totals for this day, we passed out 3 WSTF brochures to interested beach goers. We could have passed out 2 more but ran out, “Educated” one person to city laws against smoking / alcohol on city beaches, too numerous to count: plastic, cig butts, styrofoam, paper, think a lot of the balloons came from D.P. or our event they had the Arthr. Foundation & other health related things written on them. They should **ban these balloons at all the events** – the Chowder Comp is the worst, most of trash found at high water mark, most of trash found in storm drain channel, all but 2 tennis balls (of 18 found) came out from there, most trash found at high water mark.
