Comments / Recommendations:

(notes taken directly from Data Collection Sheets)

Many small pieces of Styrofoam/Also participating in this cleanup were Isobel Pelham and Tevis Swift from Maryland/Isobel Pelham helped with this clean up. Also note the large number of cigarette butts: 1/3 were collected from along the trail, 1/3 from the beach itself, and 1/3 from Linda Lane Park. Notably, there is still no cig. Butt receptacle installed next to park benches where smokers congregate. The cig. butt receptacle at the trail head is not helpful b/c smokers don't stand there to smoke. Also, the animal poo was only collected from the side of the trail. There was no poo found on the beach/ Cleaner than usual – again/Less trash than usual..wind covered up with lots of sand?/Again, lots of pieces of Styrofoam primarily at high tide line with kelp – also true of cig. Butts/
