1 flip flop, 4 ball point pens/4 flip flops, 1 T-shirt/1 right foot Rainbow sandal under El Portal Railroad Bridge/ 7 bottle caps/Bottle Lids:87, large packing styrofoam/**switchblade**, glow stick, cigarette lighter, rubber (2), wood slab/**shotgun casing**, lighter, 2 stockings/2 toys, old watch/chapstick, glowstick, sand shovel, sunglasses, towel, rubber tubing, 3 bandaids, bubble wrap/blk & fj straws, straw wraps, pl containers, meat trays, sand toys, soft bait, tennis balls, boardwax, wax wraps, shoes, utensils, cups, trash bags, wax combs, foam wrap, hanger, beach balls, sauce packets, light sticks, 6' rope, wads of fishing string, lighters, plastic plant pole, board decking, several articles of clothing, 1 mesh bag, 2 cell phones, 3 swim goggles, 1 dive mask, glasses, 4 large trash bags, bottle caps (over 1000 counted by 1 team during course of the month).

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**Comments / Recommendations:**

(notes taken directly from Data Collection Sheets)

3 Buckets of styrofoam/many small pieces of Styrofoam/many, many pieces of styrofoam/ Beach was pretty clean. The high tide in this stretch of beach (El Portal Access to Mariposa Access) helps by moving trash somewhat south maybe/plastic & paper include large items only – water bottle lids, bottles, candy wrappers- straws include straw covers/All Time Record for Butts! For some reason (don't know if tide, rain, or beach way dragged) there were several piles of seaweed and trash mixed/lots and lots of cigarettes and Styrofoam/Tide was so low we could fully clean under the pier – beer cans, bottles, candy wrappers etc. Large items not prevalent – many cigarette butts found in kelp washed ashore/many pieces of Styrofoam and (probably) a majority of cig butts found at high tide in dried kelp – would have been missed if kelp not examined/we are back on track now!/Since the summer season has ended, the beach is noticeably cleaner/Beautiful night at the beach. Kids love cleaning their beach! Beach looks great, trash was minimal/The beach was really exceptionally clean. Over 90% of the cigarette butts came from the street and parking area at Calafia.
